Congress in January 1988 (PL 100-233) to carry out a program to provide assistance to, and protect the stock of borrowers of the institutions of the Farm Credit System, and to assist in restoring System institutions to economic viability and permitting such institutions to continue to provide credit to farmers, ranchers, and the cooperatives of such, at reasonable and competitive rates. The Assistance Board is governed by a Board of Directors consisting of the Secretary of the Treasury, the Secretary of Agriculture, and an agricultural producer experienced in financial matters, appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate. The term of each member of the Board of Directors will expire when the Assistance Board is terminated.
