



# Data files and other electronic records via the National Archives Catalog

The National Archives makes some accessioned and open Federal electronic records files available online for download via the National Archives Catalog at <http://www.archives.gov/research/catalog/>.

With this option you can download entire electronic records files, along with the technical documentation and metadata needed for using the files and interpreting the records. Many of the files consist of raw data in a software-independent format so you can use the data with whatever appropriate software is available to you. Other files consist of narrative reports or documents in PDF or other formats.
