	<p>I-775 VISA WAIVER PROGRAM AGREEMENT</p> <p>This form is an agreement between a transportation line (operating between foreign territories and the United States) and the United States of America. It is for use by carriers who wish to participate in the Visa Waiver Pilot Program and the agreement enables the carriers to transport aliens without visas specifically under the terms of the waiver program. Transportation lines are not permitted to land any alien into the United States under the Non-Immigrant Visa Waiver Pilot Program until and unless it has entered into such a contract.</p> <p>This is a single form consisting of two sides, and was developed under the authority of Sections 103 and 217 of the Immigration and Nationality Act. It sets forth the agreements between the Attorney General on behalf of the United States of America and the transportation lines.</p> <p>It requires the date, title, and signature of the transportation lines representative and the Commissioner or a designee of the Immigration and Naturalization Service.</p> <p>Retention/Disposition: Destroy all copies three years after termination of agreement with carrier.</p>	NI-85-90-1/2
